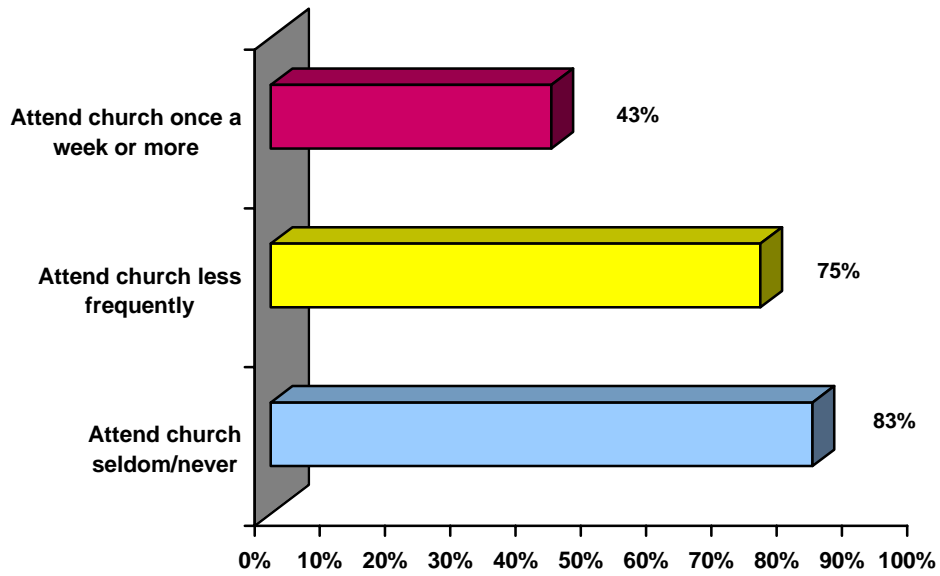


Abortion should be legal

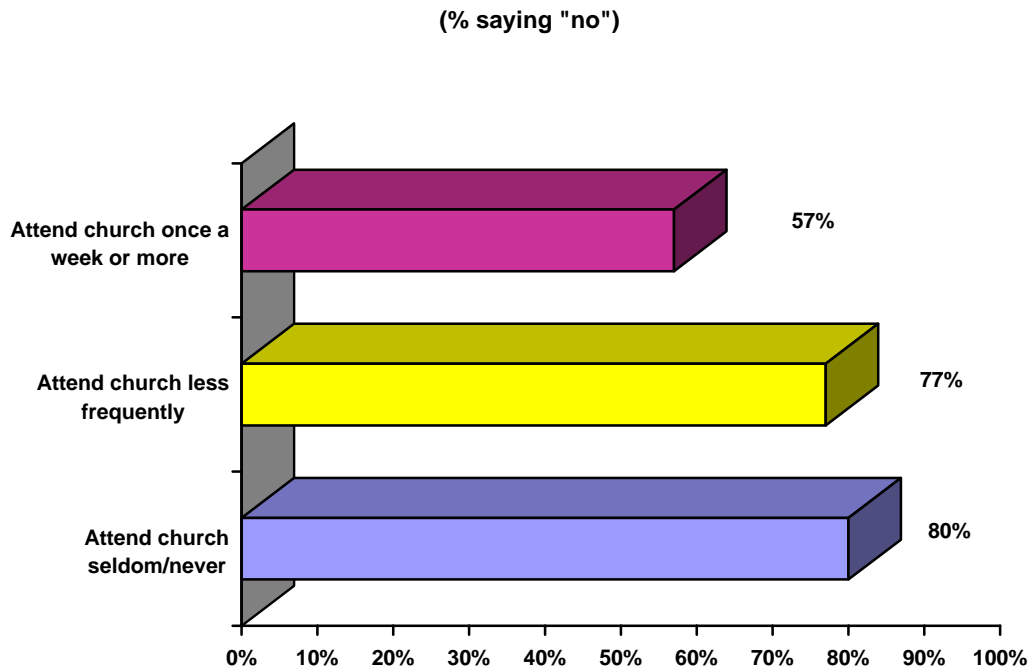

Catholics' religious obligation to vote for candidates who oppose abortion

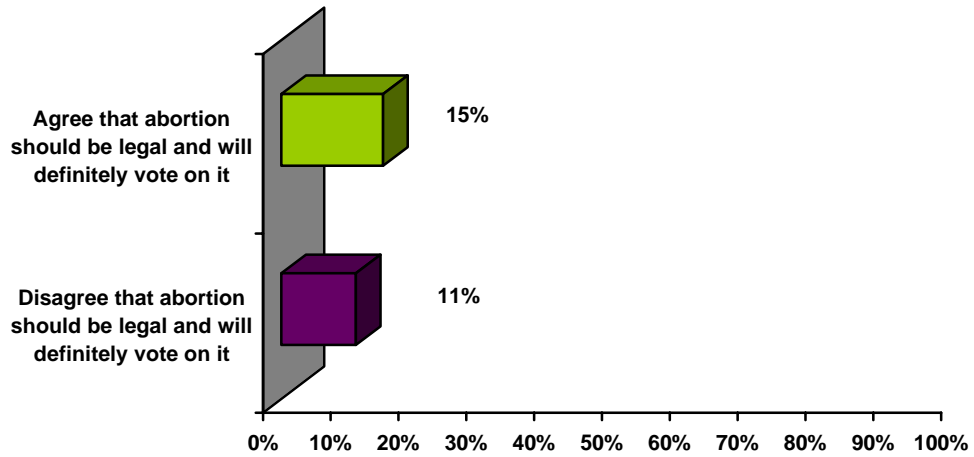


Q. Do you believe Catholics have a religious obligation to vote for candidates who oppose legal abortion?

(% of Catholic voters who...)



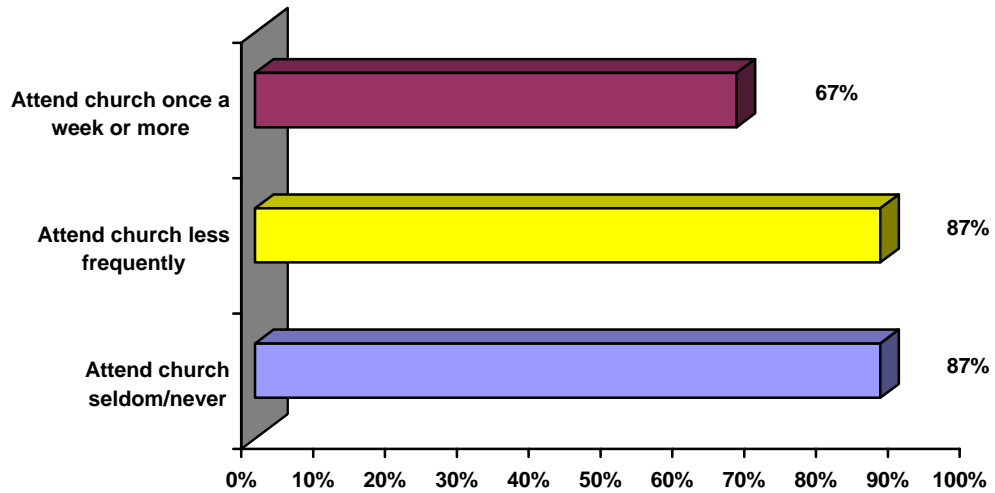

Support for the death penalty

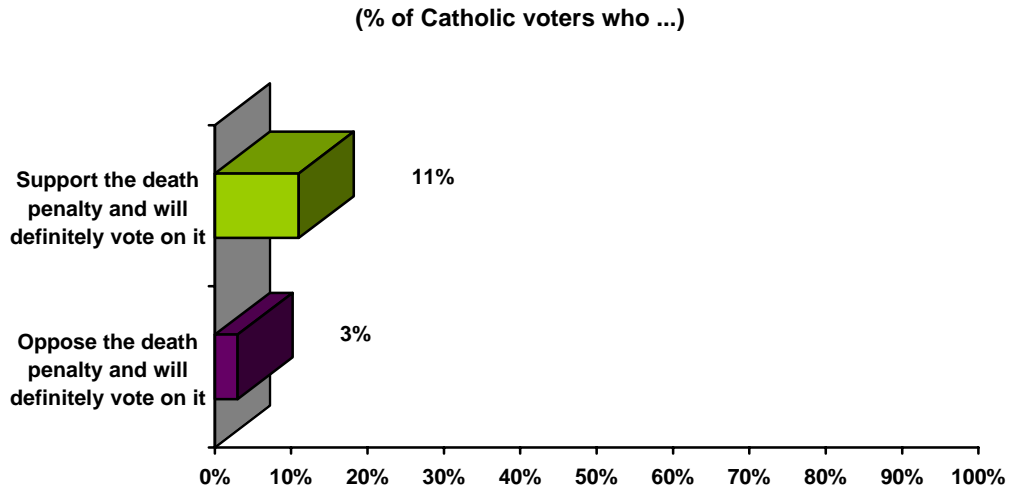

Death penalty as a voting issue



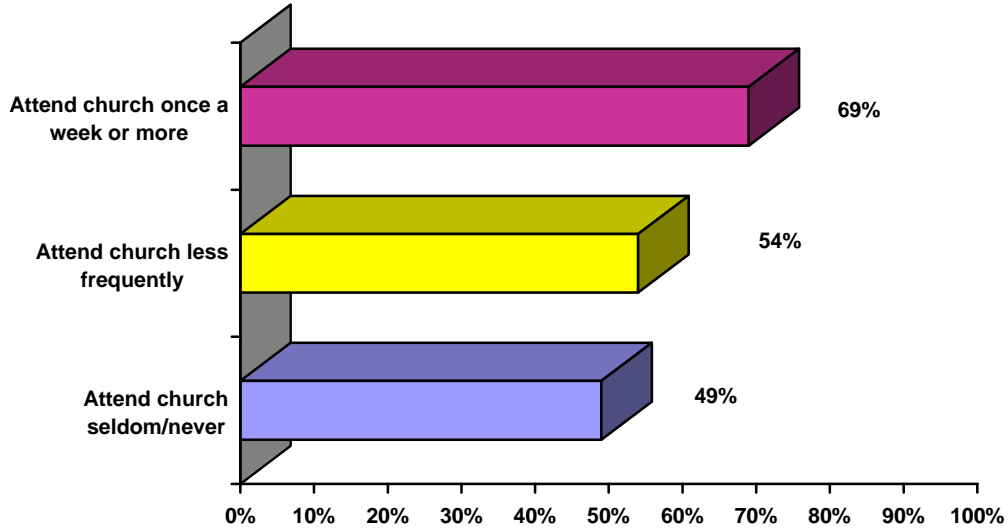

(% supporting)

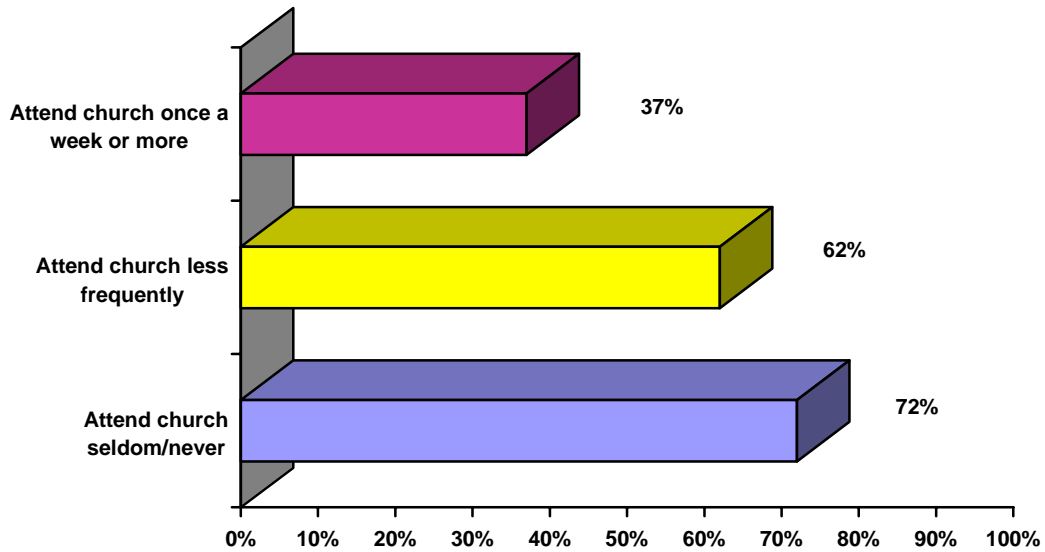


Q. School vouchers which give parents money from tax revenues to help pay tuition costs, for their children to go to private or religious school instead of public school. Do you support or oppose each of the following?

(% supporting)

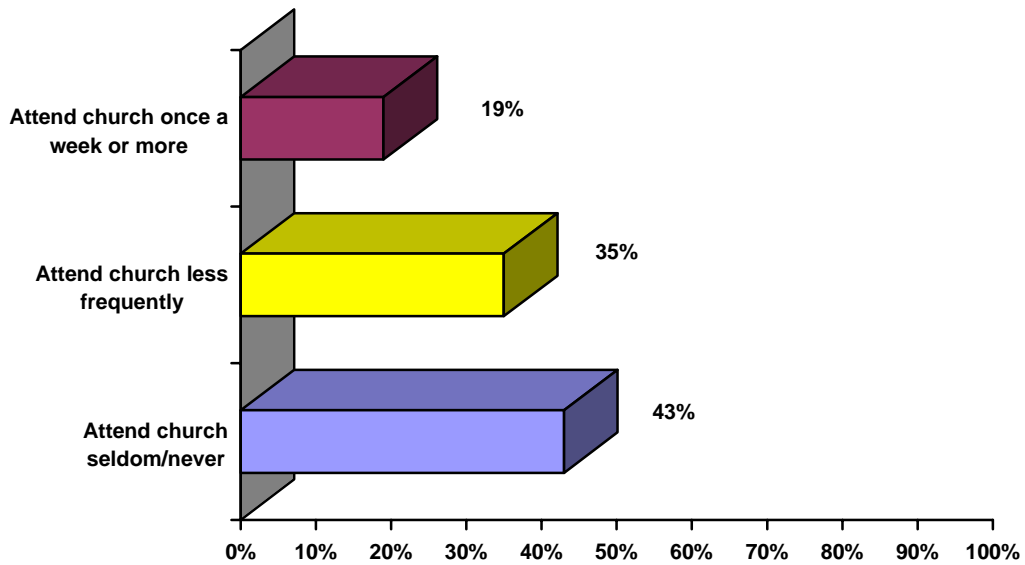


Q. Making it legal for doctors to assist in the suicide of a terminally ill patient: Do you support or oppose each of the following?
